GOVERNOR MALLOY DEDICATES NEW DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION DUI UNIT AS PART OF SECOND CHANCE

(HARTFORD, CT) – On Friday morning, April 1, Governor Dannel P. Malloy will join Department of Correction Commissioner Scott Semple and other state officials at the Cybulski Community Reintegration Center in Enfield to open the facility's new DUI Unit. The unit is a next step in Governor's Second Chance Society initiatives, aimed at supporting those incarcerated for driving under the influence with tailored services to reduce recidivism and lower crime.

WHAT: Dedication ceremony to mark the opening of the DUI Unit at the Cybulski Community Reintegration Center

WHEN: Friday, April 1, 2016; 11:00 a.m.

WHERE: *Willard-Cybulski Correctional Institution; 391 Shaker Road, Enfield*

***NOTE: All media covering this event are required to confirm their attendance with the Department of Correction's Public Information Office at DOC.PIO@ct.gov (Subject line: DUI Unit) by the end of the business day on Thursday 3/31/16 in order to process security clearances. Cell phones are prohibited within the correctional facility. Please ensure you have valid photo identification upon arrival. Attendees are encouraged to arrive no later than 10:30 a.m. to ensure there is adequate time to complete the required security protocols.*

Directions to the Cybulski Community Reintegration Center - From I-91 North:

Take I-91 north to Enfield, exit 48 (route 220). Take a right at the end of the ramp onto Elm Street (east). Go approximately one mile to a fork in the road. There is a traffic light at the fork. Bear left at the fork and go straight for several miles. Carl Robinson Correctional Institution is the first facility on the left. At the stop sign, continue straight. The **Willard Building** of the Willard-Cybulski Correctional Institution is the second left. The **Cybulski Community Reintegration Center Building** is the third left, approximately 1/2 mile after the Willard Building.
